





EYAs also assembled a toddler bed and cleaned up the pantry and refrigerator at the premises.





Kendra Scott = \$1780

In May 2023, we did a Kendra Scott Fundraiser at the Avalon Mall for Mother's Day. Flyers are passed on to promote Ekam USA and refreshments are served at the store. The total amount of funds raised from the Kendra Scott fundraiser was \$1780.27, which benefitted a local women's shelter and women's healthcare service projects in India.





Cookies for the Homeless

Our EYAS and parent volunteers made and donated 100 plus treat bags and Cookies to the homeless in Downtown Atlanta for Valentine's Day and Thanksgiving.





Python Classes = 20 students

Our chapter hosted Python Classes for underprivileged students in June and July through Zoom. Students learned basic and advanced concepts and worked on a project to showcase their learnings.

Java Classes = 10 students

During the summer, EKAM Atlanta chapter conducted online classes for 8 weeks, totaling 80 hours to teach basic to advanced level Java, for college students in India.

Hearing Aid Project

Children with congenital hearing loss causing speech and language delays were screened through organizations Koshi and DEIC Coimbatore. The project assisted Mathayan, aged 8 years male with both ears severe sensorineural hearing loss, and Priya, aged 2 years female with both ears having moderate sensorineural hearing loss.



Thalassemia Project

41 kids with Thalassemia needing blood transfusions every 2 weeks at GH, Coimbatore. We assisted them by providing transfusion supplies and filters for quarterly safe and efficient blood transfusions through 2023.


SACAS Diwali Fundraiser



Shelters supported in the USA

With the constant need to keep basic food coming, Boston families stepped up important celebrations in their life by sponsoring meals. Youth volunteers (ages 5+) prepared fresh wholesome 5271+ meal packages to feed guests at 12 different local shelters throughout the year. Raised



Orphanage Meal Sponsorship in India

Families sponsored full day meals at 5 different orphanages in Andhra and Telangana on various occasions like Anniversaries, Birthdays, Festivals and celebration of after life of loved ones etc. Our team raised \$12,563 through corporate matches to support sustainable well being projects in India.



Project Medical Kits

A total of **\$1800** was raised to provide Medical Kits for 15 bedridden cerebral palsy patients for one year, donated to poor bedridden cerebral palsy patients in Andhra and Telangana by executing partner Hope4Spandana.





Mission to Vision

We sponsored 100 Cataract Surgeries in 2023 through Marturu Camp in Prakasam District, Andhra. Budget **\$3000.** Executing Partner: Sankara Eye Foundation.

International Day of Persons with Disabilities

The Undies Project

To boost the dignity and self esteem of the marginalized girls, 2 sets of intimate wear were provided to 131 adolescent girls in 3 different homes. Budget \$500. Executing Partner: Extra Mile for a smile



Sanitary Pads

Distributed biodegradable eco friendly sanitary packs good for a year to 300 adolescents at ZPHS Jangaon dist. And to 100 girls at Refah-e-Aam high school in Hyderabad and 60 girls in "Maa Illu"' Telangana. Executing Partner: Sahaja Foundation, Hyderabad. Budget \$520



The Wish Project

104 backpacks donated to local underprivileged kids. Youth volunteers Nikhil and Jayan Byrapuram put together 104 backpacks + school supplies with \$1400 they raised to benefit kids.





Rise Against Hunger

On the occasion of the 3rd anniversary 48 youth and adult volunteers donated \$4000 and spent 4 hours at New England Warehouse to pack nutritious non-perishable food packages to feed 10,152 people in Zimbabwe. Each pack contained dry soya, dry vegetables, vitamin sachet and rice.



Savers Clothing Drive

Two rounds of Savers FunDrives (clothing drives) were conducted by several adult and youth volunteers from a dozen towns. We collected 1300+ lbs of clothes, soft/small household goods including books and delivered to the nearest Savers facility which generated a total of \$1545. Funds were spent on environment protection, sponsoring 150 trees through "TEAM TREES" locally and plantation of 100 trees in Punnaveli, Krishna Dist, Andhra.



Donations of Caps and Scarves to Turkey and Syria

Several Adult and Youth volunteers made 75 woolen caps and 95 scarves made out of fleece material. These made their way to Turkey and Syria earthquake victims.

EKAM USA: Charlotte, NC

Medical Kits for Patients = \$ 600

EKAM Charlotte donated the money for medical hygiene kits to spinal cord injury patients who are paralyzed or bedridden. These kits help them with bladder and bowel function and prevent infections. These patients cannot afford the supplies and have a long-term need for these kits. Each kit was for \$12, supporting 5 patients for 10 months.

Cyclone Michaung Flood Support

We donated 50 Blankets for victims of the Cyclone Michaung flooding that struck Chennai.

Food Pantry Support

Volunteers helped organize the pantry in Waxhaw, NC.

Sponsorship of Cataract Surgeries = 20

20 cataract surgeries were sponsored through Sankara Eye Foundation.

Bed and Mattress Donation to Old Age Home

Support for Anganwadis

We funded basic needs like weighing scales, educational and play materials for 132 Anganwadis in Madurai, Salem and Chennai, helping over 3000 kids.



Vision Care Camps & Cataract Surgeries

Recognizing that early intervention is the most cost-effective way to address vision issues in children, we partnered with Ekam Foundation to fund screening camps for 700 school children in Madurai & follow-up care for 29 kids needing prescription glasses. We supported 20 cataract surgeries in AP & Punjab.





Bicycles & Toilets for Girl Students

To facilitate transportation from remote rural areas, we funded bicycle banks with 43 bicycles in Sanikavaram and Bommalapuram schools in Andhra Pradesh. We funded a functional toilet block for girls in LKB Nagar School, Madurai.





Basic Infrastructure for PHCs

Supported 3 PHCs in Madurai with life saving equipment like a fetal doppler and an infant warmer & basic needs such as BP apparatuses, x-ray supplies, and an RO unit.



Prosthetic Limbs

We funded over 100 custom prosthetic limbs for beneficiaries in Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Telangana.







Ducklings for Widows

For livelihood support, we donated ducklings, feed and medicine to 10 widows who lost their husbands to COVID, in Jharkhand.





Blankets for Cold Winters

We supported 200 of the 1500 blankets that were distributed in Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Telangana to tribal, nomadic, and other poor people and children in orphanages.



Horizon House

Ekam Indy families have donated supplies and made 375 snack bags, and 667 sandwiches for unhoused neighbors who use the facility as a day shelter. We also donated \$500, leveraging Value Circle matching funds.



A helping hand for bed-ridden and differently-abled adolescents

We sponsored monthly medical kits for a year for 10 patients suffering from spinal cord injury or cerebral palsy who need help to dignify their situation. We also provided a water purification unit to Chellamuthu Trust in Madurai that provides rehabilitation programs for adolescents with mental illness.









Gleaners and Midwest Food Banks of Indiana

We helped with a range of tasks, e.g., sorting produce & bread, assembling food boxes, loading cars with food boxes, helping over 6000 families and 10 agencies.





Second Helpings

EYAs and parents helped sort and weigh pasta and assembled over 15000 grab'n go meals. They also made 100 pretty cards to accompany the meals delivered to A Caring Place, Damien Center & Julian Center.
