Prosthetic Limbs

Restoring Mobility and Independence Through Prosthetic Limb Support

We are honored to begin the year by restoring mobility and confidence to those in need. **500 prosthetic limbs** have been provided throughout the year—each one offering someone a renewed sense of independence, dignity, and hope.



Across the communities of Nalgonda, Bhadrachalam, Vijayawada, Miryalaguda and Khammam, in Andhra and Telangana, patients who could not otherwise afford the cost received prosthetic limbs through our ongoing service camps, supported by dedicated volunteers, partner organizations, and generous donors. At \$52 per limb, you change someone's life, mobility, confidence and livelihood.

Strengthening Livelihood Opportunities for Communities

Our goal is to support the most vulnerable and economically disadvantaged individuals and families in Tirupati by providing sustainable livelihood equipment that enhances income-generating opportunities and strengthens economic independence.



This assistance is expected to create stable income opportunities, strengthen self-reliance, and reduce dependence on irregular sources of livelihood. The project was implemented in two phases, ultimately **benefiting 24 women**, and significantly improving economic opportunities for the marginalized Mathamma community who have been systematically abused by society until now and living in the poorest conditions possible, without hope of breaking the cycle of poverty. Now these women are earning equal to or more than the men in the community!



Study Centers

Empowering Children Through After School Study Centers

The After School Study Centers Project aims to provide academic support and holistic development opportunities to 265 children from economically disadvantaged backgrounds in the slum areas of Tirupati district, Andhra Pradesh.



Implemented by SIRDS (Social Integrated Rural Development Society) and funded by EKAM USA, this initiative serves as a comprehensive community empowerment program - transforming these children and their families into responsible, literate communities. These kids who didn't stand a chance previously, now top their classes, all while living in single-room homes with daily-wage-earning parents and always says "Thank you Ekam USA"!



Clean Water in Schools

Ensuring Safe Drinking Water Through RO Plant Installation

Many rural schools continue to face significant challenges in providing clean and safe drinking water, leaving students dependent on untreated sources that increase the risk of waterborne illnesses and negatively impact both their health and learning.

Ekam USA funded an RO water purification system to a government school in Jawathu Hills, Tirupathur district, enhancing student well-being by ensuring access to clean and safe drinking water.





Disaster Relief

Supporting Communities Affected by the Southern California Wildfires

At least seven wildfires have been burning across Los Angeles and Southern California, leading to the evacuation of more than 31,000 residents and placing over 14,000 structures at risk, according to Los Angeles County's Coordinated Joint Information Center.

In response, Ekam USA donated air purifiers to support individuals with medical needs and provided essential school supplies to affected children. We remain committed to continuing our support for families impacted by the fires.
